

FEATURES OF THE SCHOOL

1. Scholarship

To promote and inculcate healthy competitive spirit, students are given scholarships for their good academic performances.

2. Smart Classes

In order to make teaching & learning process more interesting, smart classes with the use of digital boards have been introduced for all classes from class I to XII.

3. SMS Facility

Looking to the increased mobile usage, the school has started informing parents about the child's progress, holidays & other important details through SMS facility.

4. Assembly

To inculcate a high sense of National integrity and universal brotherhood, each working day in the school starts with morning assembly including school prayer, devotional and patriotic songs. Stress is also laid on the moral development of the students. News reading, reciting poems with full actions and singing songs in chorus are the remarkable features of the morning assembly. Special Assemblies on special days & festival celebration are important features of the assembly.

5. Recreational Activities

We celebrate all festivals & important days through recreational activities. Arts and crafts give a lot of creative opportunities to the students. They learn making stuffed dolls to paper work, match stick work, cardboard modelling, instrumentation etc. All these activities are displayed throughout the vear.

6. Social Activities

School organises Sports Day, Teacher's Day, Annual Day (Gyan Fest) apart from many other functions. Children are involved in these functions. For every activity, they work in groups. Every child is involved in one way or the other. Student's council is formed every year where they learn to shoulder the responsibility.

7. Cultural Activities

School gives lots of opportunities for self- expression and advancement of the cultural heritage. On Saturdays there are special programmes like dramatics, dance, music & fine arts. Every child gets the opportunity to participate.

9. House System

To induce leadership quality, healthy competition and team spirit, co curricular activities are introduced on house basis.

10. Music and Dance

School has a separate Music and Dance room for the students. Special training is given to the students.

11. Physical Education

It is imparted to the students by Mass P.T./drill, yoga and providing facilities of outdoor and indoor games to encourage healthy sportsman character, building sound body and healthy competitive spirit among the students. Excellent sports facilities with Volleyball, Net Ball, Throw Ball, Badminton, Basketball and field events are promoted in GV.

'KRIDANGANA' a reflection of sports activities organised by the school every year. Innumerable number of sports scholars of State and divisional level are exemplary examples of GV.

12. Weekly Tests

Weekly tests are conducted on every Tuesday. It is compulsory to appear in these tests. There shall be no retest and the child will be awarded zero, in case of absence.

13. Library

We have a library with a large volume of books; periodicals & course oriented journals are the special features which help us to shape the students into a versatile genius.

14. Labs

Well-equipped labs of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer, and English are in the school. These are made in the most modern way with a capacity of 50 students at a time.

15. Computer Education

Computer education is an integral part of the school curriculum. Computer labs are well equipped with latest computers where students are exposed to windows and other high level languages with a Wi-Fi campus.

16. Parents - Teachers' Meetings

GYANASTHALIAWARDS

Merit Certificate: A Merit Certificate shall be awarded to students who attain 100% attendance.

Trophies / Medals: Trophies/Medals shall be awarded to students for proficiency in extracurricular activities & sports.

Roller's Trophy:

- (A) Chairperson's Cup: Chairperson's Cup shall be awarded to the best all rounder student of the school.
- **(B) Director's Cup:** Director's Cup shall be awarded to the student who is best in sports.
- **(C) Principal's Cup:** Principal's Cup shall be awarded to the student who is best in academics.
- **(D) Most Smartly dressed student of The Year:** This Cup shall be awarded to student who is most smartly dressed.

FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF ANY ACADEMIC AWARD

- (1) The student must appear in all examinations. If a child misses two Assessments in one subject in one term, he /she will not be eligible for any academic award.
- (2) Academic Awards will be awarded only to those students who continue to be in the school in the next class.
- (3) Children using unfair means in examinations will not be eligible for any academic awards.

OUR HOUSE SYSTEM

- There are four houses in the school. Every student on admission is placed in one of these houses.
- The houses are: Ashoka House, Bharat House, Raman House and Tagore House.
- Each house is headed by a boy or a girl known as House Captain. A member of the staff assisted by several other teachers' acts as the House Masters. Points are awarded to students throughout the year for academics, extracurricular activities games and sports. At the end of the year the houses gaining the highest number of point are awarded **running trophies**.
- Inter House competitions are organized in Sports, Debates, Extempore, Speech, Creative Writing, Slogan Writing & Test of Reasoning, Quiz, Art, Music.

SCHOOL LIBRARY

The School Library is open to all bonafide students of the school. All classes from Class III on wards are provided with one Library period per week. Students have to observe the following rules:

- They must maintain absolute silence in the library.
- Students from class V onwards are allowed to borrow book on their own library cards.
- Book other than reference books are issued for one week.

- Book marked, disfigured or damaged will have to be replaced or paid for by the borrower.
- The Library has an open shelf system and student must help to maintain order in the different shelves. They must put the books at the same place after reading and not just anywhere on the shelves.
- Students are not allowed to bring their personal books or belongings to the library.
- If the book is lost or damaged, the double cost of the book will be charged.
- The school authorities have the right to ask child to return the book before due date, if necessary.
- In case of loss of card, a duplicate card will be issued at a cost of Rs. 50/-.

BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS

Birthdays, being important days in our lives, are looked at as an occasion of coming together and sharing. We traditionally teach children that a kind deed done on this special day could sow seeds which will reap fruits later in our lives. So we permit children to distribute a toffee/chocolate/pencil/pen only to their classmates.

We request parents not to send any cakes or return gifts but to send only toffee or chocolate of maximum Rs.5/-. Or a pen or pencil of max Rs. 10/-.

LANGUAGE POLICY

At Gyanasthali, we believe language is a vital tool for learning, communicating and being an active member of a global society. Our Language Policy communicates to all stakeholders the teaching-learning philosophy, processes and practices along with a balanced approach towards learning of the languages acknowledging the range of abilities and diversities within the school community.

The language of instruction used to deliver the curriculum at the Gyanasthali is **English**, one of the official languages of India. The language of the region is Hindi and in fact Hindi is also the mother tongue or first language of many of our students and staff.

THE HOMEWORK

A reasonable amount of academic effort outside the class extends learning and reinforces study skills.

Homework activities can promote independent enquiry and demonstrate the pupil's initiative as a learner.

Students should do their work independently, in an environment that suits their temperament, learning style and energy curve. Parents can assist their children by ensuring that the appropriate setting exists. Generally, teachers do not assign work that they believe a child cannot do alone. The teachers allots the HW according to the need of an hour.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

Gyanasthali expects their students to show full respect to the whole school community at all times and to value school buildings, grounds and property.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS:

- Students need to attend school regularly & punctually.
- Every student should bring his/her Almanac to school every day.
- Students should be habitually clean and always neatly dressed. Students who are not in proper uniform will not be allowed to enter their classroom.
- Changing of class rooms between periods should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.
- No student is allowed to leave the class or school premises during school hours without the permission of the Principal.
- Running in corridors is strictly prohibited. Students are advised not to linger about in corridor after period/break.
- All school property must be taken care. No students should scratch or spoil the desks or chairs or damage any school furniture or write or draw anything on the walls.
- Any damage caused by the students will be made good by the concerned student/students along
 with a fine imposed on him/her for the same.
- The school has banned to bring valuable articles viz. expensive watches, mobile, cameras, and calculators to the school.
- The conduct of every student should be polite and courteous no matter wherever they are. They should always remember that the school is judged by their conduct.
- Students must greet their teachers when they meet them. Bullying and use of abusive language are punishable offences.
- Observance of disciplinary rules of the school and good behaviour are essential conditions for a student's continuance at the school.
- The school insists on the maintenance of strict discipline. Any child who violates the set of rules of the school discipline will not be allowed to attend the school.
- Laboratory Breakages: In case of deliberate laboratory damage, the students will have to pay the cost of the equipment's damages, along with a penalty of 10% of the cost of the damaged items.
- It is compulsory to have 75% attendance. Students falling short of 75% attendance will not be allowed to take any school Exam/ Board Exam.

SUSPENSION/DISMISSAL

The school reserves the right to suspend, dismiss a student if he / she does not follow to the student's code of conduct. Acts of indiscipline as listed below will be severely dealt with:-

- Coming late to school regularly.
- Staying away from classes, morning assembly or other activities.
- Misusing school property, scribbling on walls, furniture, and toilet walls etc. Copying or seeking help in the examination hall.
- Mishandling laboratory and class equipment.

For any deed of misconduct/indiscipline, the student will be warned once, second time parents will be called and third repetition will call for dismissal/suspension of the student from the school.

RULES FOR WITHDRAWAL

- One month's notice in writing or a month's fee in lieu of notice should be given before a pupil can be withdrawn.
- Transfer Certificate will be issued after the settlement of all school dues.
- Student can be asked to leave the school on either disciplinary grounds or on account of unsatisfactory progress in their work.
- Any student who fails twice in the same class will not be permitted to continue at school.
- When a withdrawal takes place due to the above reasons. The question of charging a month's fee
 in lieu of notice does not arise.

EXPECTATION FROM PARENTS

- Parents are requested to ensure that their ward reach to school on time.
- ➤ Regularity at school is imperative for good results. Hence parents are requested not to apply for their wards leave, if avoidable.
- Leave for half day should not be sought for security reasons. In case of emergency, it is permitted but after showing the Escort Card.(Without escort Card no one will be allowed).
- Children, when sick, should not be sent to school to attend test / classes.
- It is compulsory for the students to secure 75% of attendance to make him /her eligible to appear for the Second Annual Examination.
- A student will be allowed to appear in final exams only if his/her fee dues are cleared up to Sept and Feb. Of every session.
- If your ward is absent from school, he/she should make up for all work that has been missed by him/ her.
- > See that your ward (s) carries books according to the time table of the day. No extra books are allowed.

- Parents are expected to check the Almanac of their ward(s) everyday to note homework and other instruction given by teachers.
- > Parents are requested not to give very expensive stationary items to their wards.
- ➤ Parents are required to inform the school if there is any change in their address and/or telephone/ mobile numbers immediately.
- Parents are requested to ensure that their children maintain personal hygiene like trimming of nails and getting proper hair cut at regular intervals.
- Parents must refer the school almanac, note & circulars before making enquiries through phone.

Any communication made by the Parents/ Guardians should be addressed to the Principal and all the correspondence from the school to the parents will be done by the Principal.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE RULES:-

- 1. All the students are expected to maintain 100% attendance in the school.
- 2. All the students from class I to class XII should have the minimum of 75% attendance to appear in any exxam.
- 3. Students participating in National/State/Zonal level events must have the minimum of 65% attendance. These events will be treated as duty, if approved by the School. Such students will have to submit the supportive documents of participation against the leave.
- 4. Leaves will be granted only on reasons like prolonged illness, demise of a parent or any other reason of similar serious nature, authorized participation in sponsored tournaments, cultural events and sports meets of not less than inter School Level. Permission would be granted only for events approved by school Principal.
- 5. While sanctioning the leave applied for reasons other than those mentioned above, class Teacher / Principal may sanction leave based on student's previous leave record, performance, behavior and any other priority or event in the School. The School reserves the right to decline a leave.
- 6. Student must avail a leave only in case of urgency.
- Leaves should be intimated through this Leave Application form seeking permission from the class teacher. Other than an emergency, approval of the leave/s should be sought at least five days in advance.
- In case of unforeseen circumstances the child must submit a leave application clearly stating the reason for absence, on the day he/she joins back School.
- 7. Class Teacher is authorized to sanction leave up to 2 days. Leave for three days or more will be sanctioned by the Principal. In case of an emergency where the leave could not be applied in advance, intimation can be sent to the School through email or call and the leave application must be submitted to the Class Teacher on the first day of resuming the school.
- 8. A Medical certificated issued by a Registered Medical Practitioner/Hospital as applicable must support the leave on Medical ground. The requisite certificate is required to be submitted on the day the student joins the school after availing the leave. In case the absence is likely to exceed three days, an interim Medical (sickness) Certificate is required to be submitted within three days.
- 9. A student joining after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease or any serious ailment is required to produce a certificate of fitness issued by the concerned doctor / holidays permitting him / her to attend the School.
- 10. Attendance on the last working day of school preceding vacations / holidays and the first working day thereafter is compulsory. No leave shall be granted for any extension of holidays before or after especially for social gatherings or trips.
- 11. Attendance on all important events/functions in compulsory. The students found absent, are liable to face disciplinary action.
- 12. Short leave will not be permitted unless there is dire emergency.
- 13. Students with attendance below the prescribed level or indulging in frequent absenteism or where leave is not authorized for certain reason (s) by the School, will call for action.
- 14. Repeated absence without prior sanction of leave, unexplained absence for more than 10 consecutive days renders the student's admission liable to be cancelled.
- Every absence (due to sickness or otherwise) must be entered briefly in the Record of Absence page of the Almanac and signed by parents or guardians.
- Parents are requested to send a leave application (in school format).

GUIDELINES TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

GYANASTHALI VIDYALAYA is a progressive and up growing institution. In order to realise the highest ideal of education, to nurture the sterling qualities of an all round personality and to inculcate healthy competition with maintenance of individual identities under perfect care without constraining inherent qualities. We at GV need your co-operation with all your resources (Physical, Social and Economical) in this to help us in achieving our goal.

- 1. Parents must regularly visit school's website to know the necessary information's of the school's activities. They can also respond or give their feedback through SMS facility provided by the school.
- 2. Any communication made by the Parent/Guardian should be addressed to the Principal.
- 3. Students are advised not to bring valuable articles. School shall not undertake any responsibility for the loss.
- 4. Parents are required to co-operate with the school in its attempt to help their children progress by paying attention to their regularity, punctuality and discipline and take interest in their child's work. They should check the almanac every day and note the homework and other instructions given. They are advised to check the bags of their wards to see if any circular/notice/invitation etc. has been issued.
- 5. Care must be taken of all school property and if any damage is done, it will be made good by the concerned student together with a fine imposed for the offence.
- 6. All students are expected to join the school on the notified date at the beginning of the term.
- 7. Once the name is struck off from the roll, readmission can be done with due permission of the Principal.
- 8. Parents must first consult the school calendar, date sheets and other circulars, before making enquiries on the phone.
- 9. Parents must provide the school with correct mobile numbers and also inform about the changes (if any) so that SMS containing important messages can be sent to them.
- 10. Parents are requested to inform the school if there is any change in their address and telephone numbers.
- 11. Children when sick should not be sent to school to attend tests/classes.
- 12. Parents are requested not to enter classroom to see their children or teachers during school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
- 13. The name, class, section & house of the pupil should be clearly marked on all belongings of the child. School will not be responsible for lost materials.
- 14. The ward of those parents, who avoid meeting the school authorities when advised to do so, may not be allowed to attend the class.
- 15. Parents should ensure that their wards prepare their lessons well and do their homework regularly.
- 16. Parents should make sure that for any absence from the school, written intimation is sent to the class teacher. In case of emergency only, short leave will be given.
- 17. Students will not be allowed to go for drinking water after every period except for the Short Break. If in case it is required, the students are requested to bring water bottles to school.
- 18. Important messages are communicated, well in advance, through the students or through remarks of class teachers in their diary or SMS. Students will be responsible for any misinterpretation of any rule of keeping the parents in the dark about the remarks given by the authority of the School.
- 19. Students are not **allowed to bring Mobile phones in school**. If any student is found with a Mobile phone, the phone will be retained by the school minimum for 6 months by the school.
